We understand that this change may be difficult for families. Whilst the blanket provision of meal vouchers is no longer possible, Richmond Council have other support available to residents.

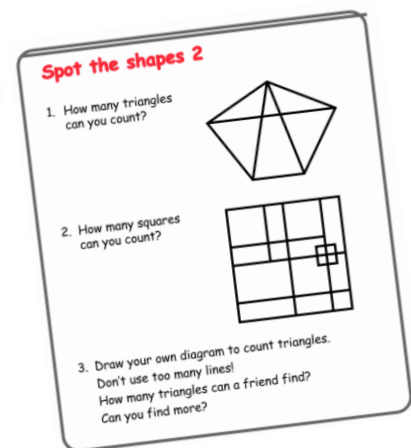
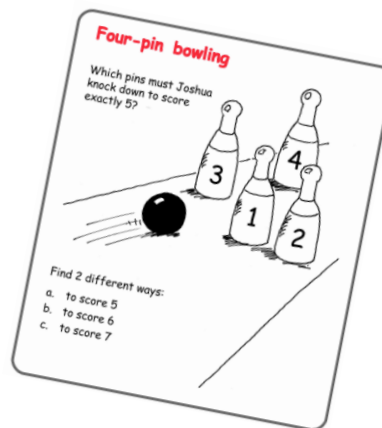

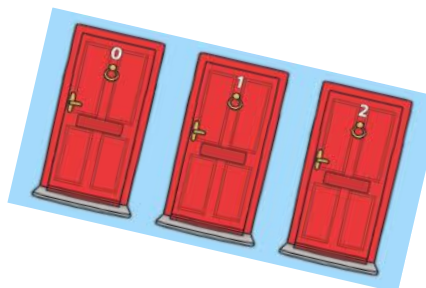
We are celebrating **National Numeracy Day** and **No Screens Day** on **Thursday, the 21st of May**.
