Dr Jerricah Holder is a Child and Educational Psychologist, trainer, and creator of the School Wellbeing Cards. With over ten years' experience working alongside children, families, and schools, she specialises in understanding barriers to school attendance and wellbeing, particularly where children are experiencing anxiety, overwhelm, or distress connected to school. Jerricah advocates a compassionate, child-centred, and neurodiversity-affirming approach, supporting schools and families to better understand children's experiences, reduce barriers within environments, and help children feel safe, understood, and able to belong.

The Road Back: Supporting Your Family When School Feels Out of Reach

It draws on the Moving from Recovery to Rediscovery model to help you understand where your child might be right now, why rest and recovery matter before anything else, and what gently re-engaging with life and learning can begin to look like. We'll explore how to rebuild feelings of safety and wellbeing as the foundation for change — and help you find a hopeful, sustainable path forward, one step at a time.
